

Who vs. Whom Worksheet #1 Answers

1. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “I handed the ticket to *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
2. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “I will interview *her/him* first,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
3. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* will take out the trash,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
4. Whomever—Responding to the sentence, you get: “I will ask *her/him* to accompany me,” therefore *whomever* is the correct answer.
5. Whoever—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* baked the cookies,” therefore *whoever* is the correct answer.
6. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* was the 30th President,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
7. Whoever—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* asked for them first,” therefore *whoever* is the correct answer.
8. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* is making all that noise,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
9. Whomever—Responding to the sentence, you get: “The police officer wrote up *him/her*,” therefore *whomever* is the correct answer.
10. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “Make out the check to *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
