

Who vs. Whom Worksheet #2 Answers

1. Whomever—Responding to the sentence, you get: “Gina smirked at *her/him*,” therefore *whomever* is the correct answer.
2. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* is attending the event,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
3. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “They invited *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
4. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* is----,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
5. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “They told *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
6. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* was my lab partner,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
7. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “I was praising *her/him* last week,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
8. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “I am traveling to the conference with *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
9. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* is my professor this quarter,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
10. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* knows the secret code,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
