

## Who vs. Whom Worksheet #3 Answers

1. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “You can trust *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
2. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* is the one who will take over,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
3. Who—Answering the question, you get: “I am *he/she*,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
4. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* is the woman who sold us her car,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
5. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “I asked out *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
6. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* gave me the answers,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
7. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “I am throwing a surprise party for *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
8. Whom—Answering the question, you get: “I am attending the party with *her/him*,” therefore *whom* is the correct answer.
9. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* gave me that watch,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
10. Who—Answering the question, you get: “*He/she* can answer your question,” therefore *who* is the correct answer.
